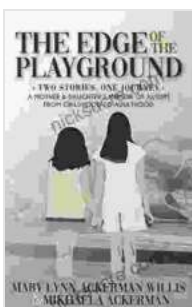

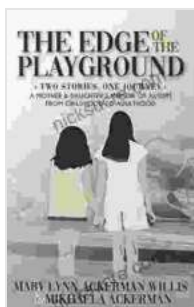

Emma O'Brien is a young woman with autism who is passionate about advocating for others with autism. She is a public speaker, writer, and

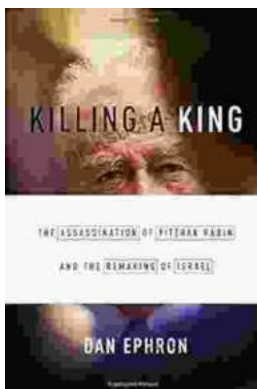
