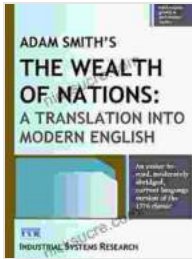

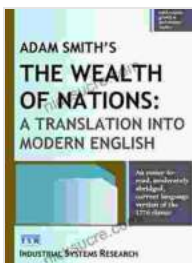
## **Impact**
