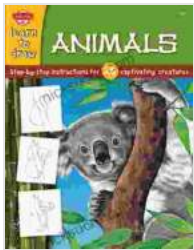

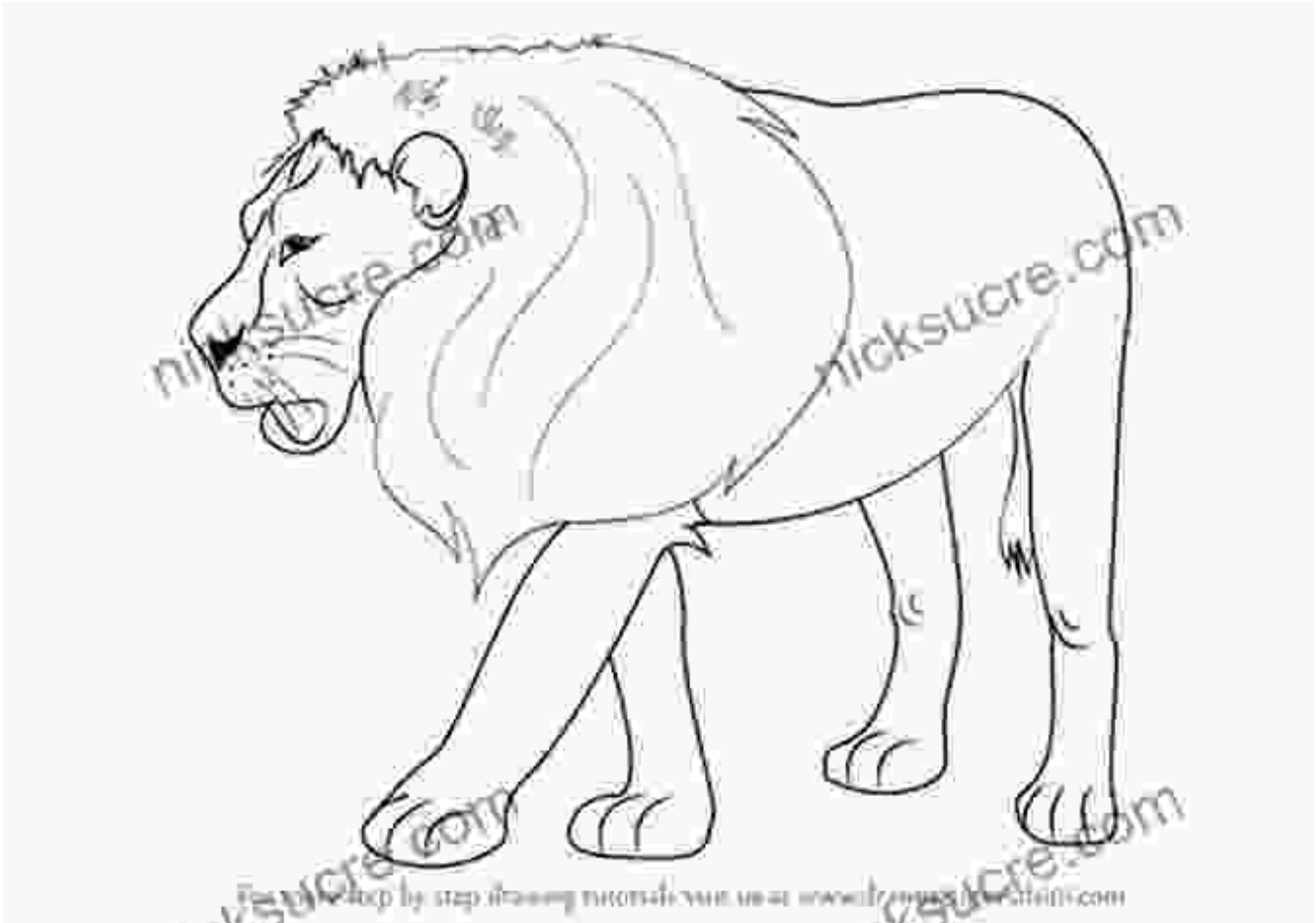

Materials

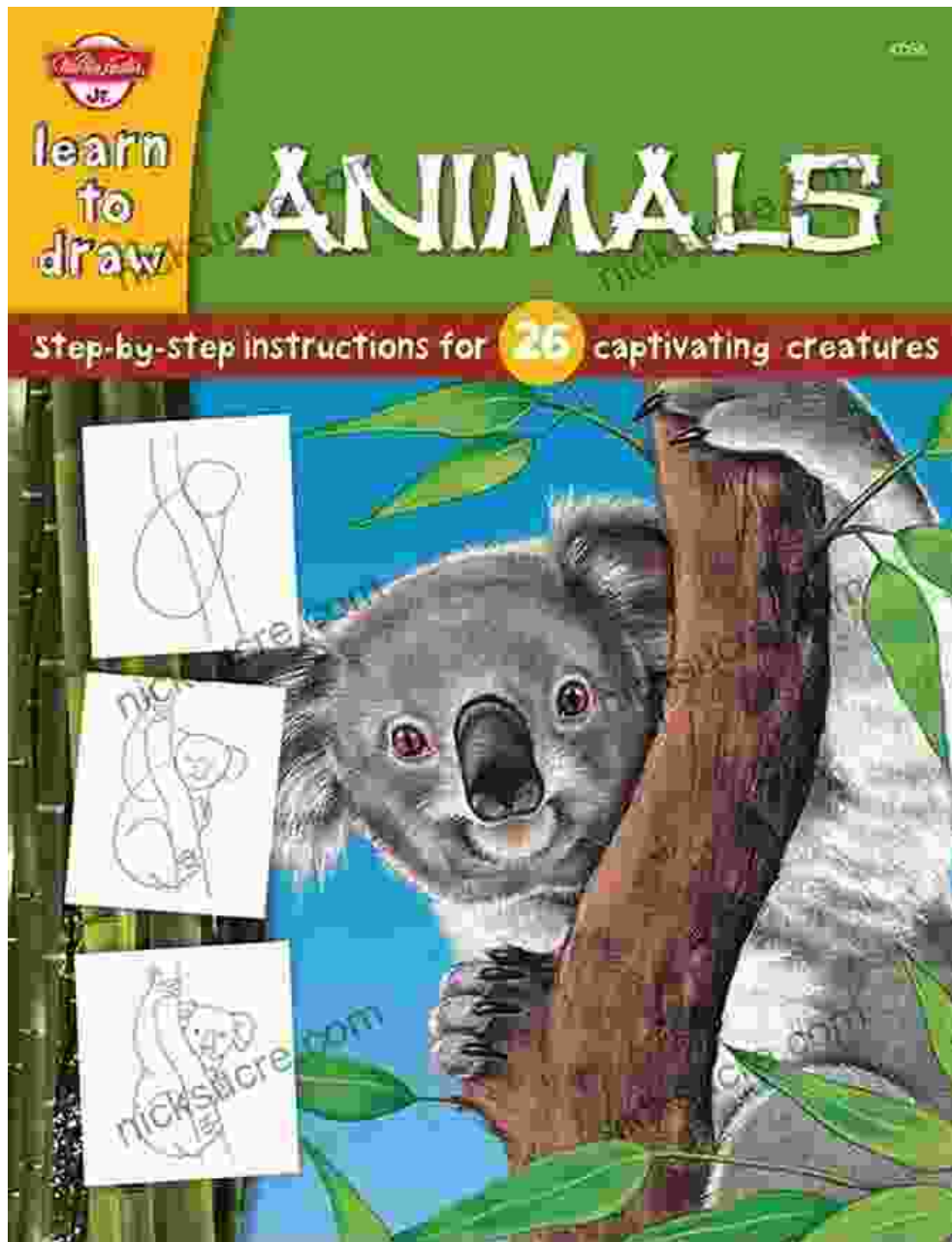

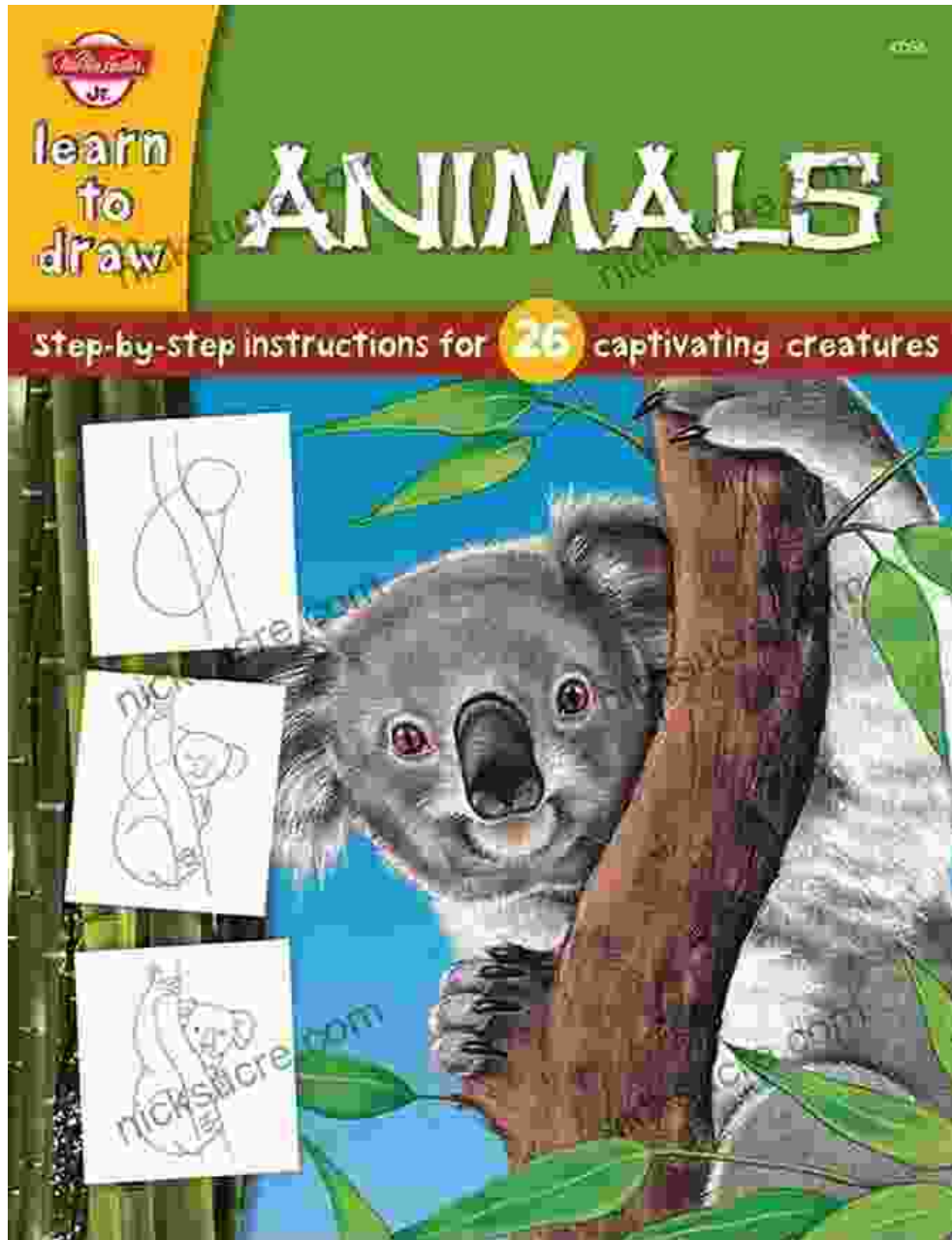

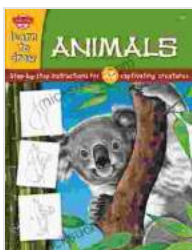
