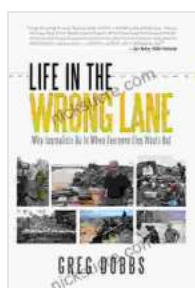


Life in the Wrong Lane: A Long and Winding Road of Unconventional Choices
