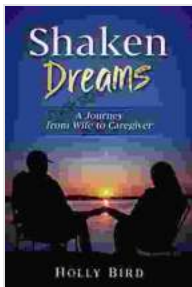

time for myself to recharge and refocus. I have also found solace and support in connecting with other caregivers, sharing our experiences and offering each other encouragement.

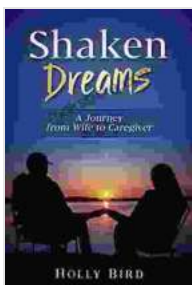

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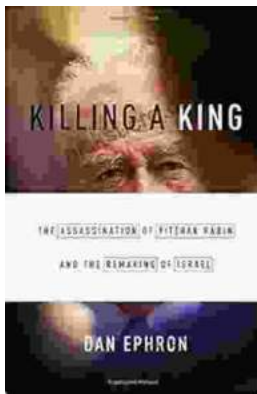
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
