
The Immigrant - A Memorable Story From My Four-Legged Stool



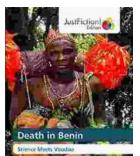
