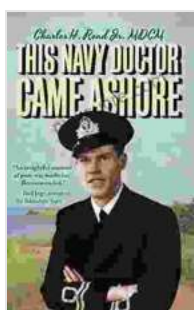


This Navy Doctor Came Ashore, Bringing Hope and Healing to a Remote Island Community

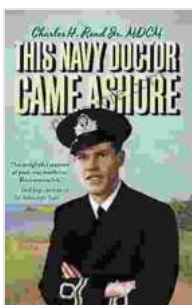

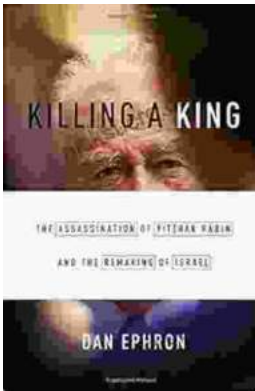
