## Celebrating Canadian Innovations

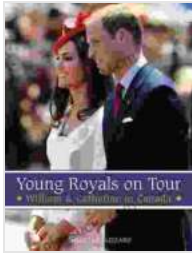

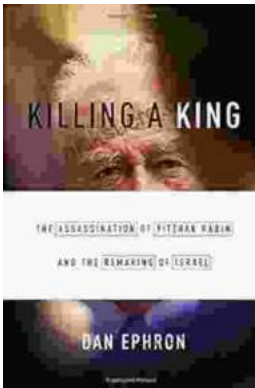
